## SUMMARY

This workshop is designed to provide compliance assistance to municipalities that have received permit coverage to discharge storm water from their Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4). The workshop will provide assistance in the development of a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Initiative (SWPPI) or Storm Water Management Program (SWMP).

Presenters will focus in detail on developing a representative sampling program for Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) waterbodies, understanding post-construction storm water control for new development and redevelopment requirements, and developing and implementing a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) for municipal fleet maintenance and storage yards. Please note that the SWPPP training will focus on municipal facilities and will not cover industrial facilities.

A large volume of compliance assistance documents have been developed for MS4 permit requirements and these are available **on-line**. Due to time constraints, an overview of these materials will be presented at the workshop, with limited information being presented on some of the requirements.

*This workshop is recommended for managers of municipal facilities, municipal planners, municipal officials, and environmental consultants.*
