## Greening Mid-Michigan Project Update

Green infrastructure is often defined as an interconnected network of green space and other environmental assets that conserves the functions of the natural ecosystem and provides associated benefits to people. Proactively planning to protect natural resources and reduce pollution from stormwater runoff while improving the quality of life for Mid-Michigan residents is the primary reason the GLRC and others are working in conjunction with Tri-County Regional Planning Commission (TCRPC) to raise awareness about green infrastructure and the importance of planning for it.

The regional green infrastructure vision poster plan will be completed by MI Natural Features Inventory in September 2010. The poster plan will include the green infrastructure map, process details and an overview of planning projects in the region. TCRPC will be regionally promoting the plan throughout the fall.

## Ordinance/BMP Committee Continues LID Presentation Series

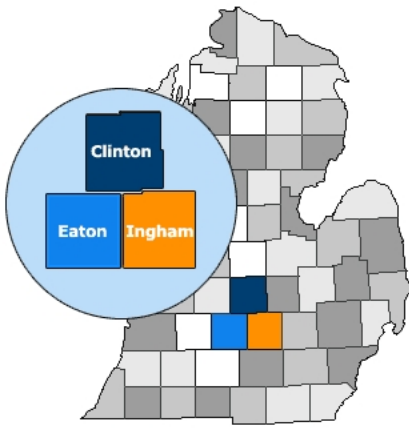
