



SMART SALTING STEPS

One teaspoon of salt will pollute 5 gallons of water!



SHOVEL FIRST

Early and frequent snow removal is the best practice to minimize salt use.



USE LESS

One 12 oz. coffee mug holds enough salt to treat a 20-foot driveway or 10 sidewalk squares.



SCATTER SMART!

Use salt only where critical and scatter salt so there is 3 inches in between grains.



SWITCH

Salt won't melt ice below 15°F; switch to a different deicer in low temps or use sand for traction.



SWEEP AND SAVE

Sweep up and save extra sand or salt and reuse later to protect waterways and save money.
